

8. Setting Up an English Language Environment by Having an English Corner / Room

- **Structured**
 - Theme and style, festivals, seasons, special school occasions
- **Display**
 - Children's work on the wall, thematic tables, magnetic boards, wall dictionary
- **Create English rich atmosphere**
 1. Label things in the corner / room
 2. Posters (animals, fruit, food, map, numbers, alphabet)
 3. Rules in the corner
- **Create a warm and comfortable environment**
 1. Colourful decorations
 2. Cushions
 3. Mattresses
 4. Stools and desks
 5. Big bean bags
 6. Toys
 7. A corner for self-access learning
- **Items put into the corner / room**
 1. Display boards or writing boards for children
 2. A bookshelf for English storybooks
 3. A CD player or tape recorder for playing music, English songs

5. English games – board games, crossword puzzle, chess
6. TV with video recorder and DVD player and a variety of films/videos
7. Paper & pens / art supplies, i.e. crayons for drawing and colouring
8. Books (graded), comics, puppets and word cards
9. Computers – software

11. A reading corner with headphones and recorders
12. A shopping corner
