“Hong Kong Clean PC Day 2010” is an information security awareness program jointly organized by Hong Kong Computer Emergency Response Team Coordination Centre (HKCERT), the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer (OGCIO), and Hong Kong Police Force (HKPF). The objective of the program is to reach out to schools, small business and individual users to provide information about safe use of the Internet and promote better security awareness.

The program includes a series of awareness education activities. We make a call to the public to scan their computers for possible malware and patch security vulnerabilities on the special day, i.e. 24th November 2010. We have also organized a series of public seminars from this point onwards and invite security experts and law enforcement to share with your staff and students the information security threats trends and the importance of adopting protection measures.
