

Applied Learning (ApL) Courses

Same as Procedure 2007, a pass in a quality-assured ApL course (formerly known as career-oriented curriculum course) will be counted as one point for central allocation at Stage V. Individual schools have the discretion to decide whether to count these points for S6 admission in Stages I to IV. The maximum number of points accumulated for S6 admission is two. The point awarded on merit of the ApL qualification will be printed on the S6 Admission Slip. Some admission examples are provided at the above link of EDB homepage. Schools wishing to count the points for the ApL courses for S6 admission in Stages I to IV are required to inform students and EDB of the admission criteria in advance.
