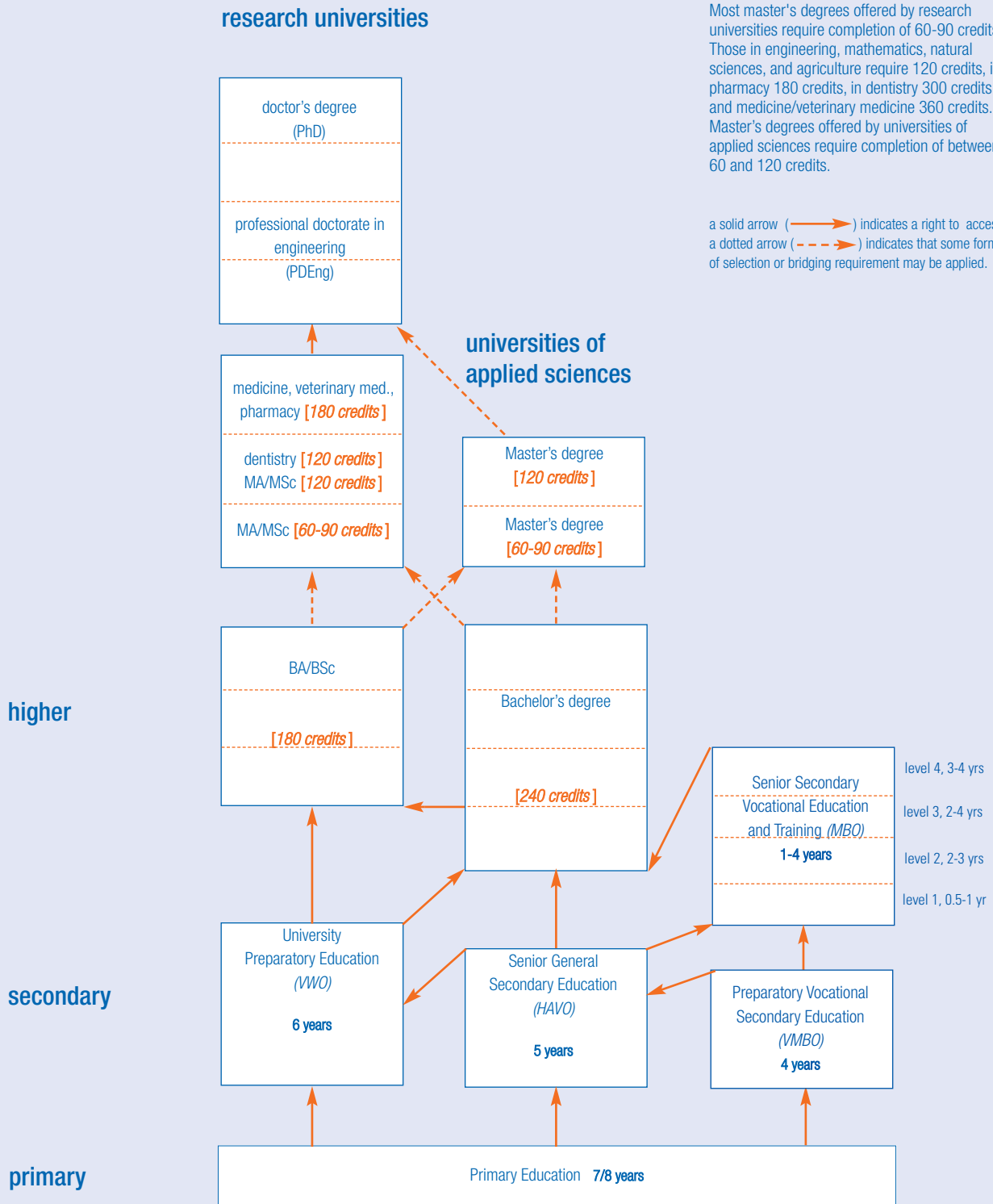


Diagram of the Dutch Education System



Most master's degrees offered by research universities require completion of 60-90 credits. Those in engineering, mathematics, natural sciences, and agriculture require 120 credits, in pharmacy 180 credits, in dentistry 300 credits and medicine/veterinary medicine 360 credits. Master's degrees offered by universities of applied sciences require completion of between 60 and 120 credits.
