

## II. AIM OF REMEDIAL TEACHING

Remedial Teaching is intended for students who, for one reason or another, have fallen behind the rest of the class.

At the beginning of a remedial course, the teacher has to assess with care the strengths and weaknesses of her students. As there are usually not more than 20 students in each remedial group, the remedial class teacher is expected to pay greater attention to individual weaknesses and needs. Her ultimate aim is to help such students learn to the best of their ability and to bring them back into the mainstream classes as far as possible.
