


What study programmes will be favourable to HMSC students?

HMSC provides students with the opportunity to develop a holistic view of health and social care through planning and involvement in personal, groups and community learning and action, as well as the application of strategies of social advocacy. It will favour their further studies in Medicine, Nursing, Social Work, Psychology, Sociology, etc



What work industry will be favourable to HMSC students?

HMSC provides students with the opportunities to observe, visit, organise activities or have contacts with the service users and equips them with service experiences, basic skills and fundamental knowledge related to health and social care, so as to become enthusiastic and capable workers serving at different levels in the health and social welfare services, such as doctor, nurse, social worker, psychologist, counsellor, teacher, welfare worker, health worker, healthcare assistant.
