School-based Gifted Education Programmes Interview with Self-nominated Student

- 1. Clarification of the student's expectation
 - Why do you want to participate in the programme?
 - What do you expect to gain from the programme?
 - The committee may introduce the objectives of the programme and the requirements for the student and the parents.
- 2. Self-confidence and talents
 - What potential/ expertise/ strength do you think you possess that makes you to be selected by the committee?

If writing is the student's expertise/ interest, ask him/her to share some writing experience and knowledge with you.

The interviewer may also ask the student if a writer is to be invited to give a talk at the school, whom will he/she invite? Why?

- 3. Learning attitude and eagerness
 - Have you come across difficulties in your studies? How did you overcome the difficulties?
 - What is your most outstanding expertise? How much time do you spend on this expertise? What satisfaction can you get from it?

For example, we can find out how much the student likes his/her expertise/interest, such as writing, and how much time does he/she spend on writing?

What does he/she prepare before writing?

What satisfaction can he/she get from writing?

What difficulties has he/she encountered? How to handle them?
