**Guidelines for Uploading School Principal's Nomination Forms
for the Scheme for Admission of Hong Kong Students to Mainland Higher Education
Institutions 2014
("the Scheme")**

I am pleased to inform you that the captioned Scheme whereby Hong Kong students are exempted from taking the Joint Entrance Examination for Universities in the Mainland, and Mainland higher education institutions would admit Hong Kong students based on their Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) examination results will continue to be implemented in 2014. 75 Mainland higher education institutions will participate in the Scheme in 2014 (see **Appendix 1**).

According to the enrolment procedure for the Scheme promulgated by the Ministry of Education (國家教育部), student applicants have to submit their applications online during the period from **25 February to 20 March 2014** (via the website: <http://www.ecogd.edu.cn>). They should also visit the China Education Exchange (HK) Centre for onsite confirmation of applications (現場確認) during the period from **15 to 31 March 2014 (except Sundays)**.

There will be a refinement to the procedure this year, whereby **student applicants are required to upload their Student Learning Profiles (SLPs) (in Chinese or English, preferably in Chinese) on their own via the online application system during the period from 25 February to 20 March 2014**. Further details will be announced via the online application website of the Co-Office of the Mainland Chinese Universities and Colleges of P.R. China for the Joint Examinations and Enrolment of the Students from Hong Kong, Macao, Taiwan and Overseas Chinese-Resident Areas and Countries (Joint Enrolment Office) (<http://www.ecogd.edu.cn>).

Similar to last year, school principals can nominate a maximum of 3 students among all students taking the HKDSE examination in 2014 and should submit School Principal's Nomination Forms (SPNFs) for them (if any) online during the period from **1 April to 31 May 2014** (a sample of SPNF at **Appendix 2**). Details of requirements for uploading SPNFs are described in the attached Guidelines (see **Appendix 3**).

Schools will be informed of the website, together with the username and password, for uploading of SPNFs in due course.
