### "Information Literacy for Hong Kong Students" Learning Framework (2024)

## **Summary**

Ref.

This circular memorandum aims to announce the updating of the "Information Literacy for Hong Kong Students" Learning Framework and the related learning and teaching support measures.

## Background

2. To strengthen the relevant information literacy learning elements in primary and secondary curricula and to further enhance students' information literacy to meet the challenges brought about by the rapid development of the digital world, the Education Bureau (EDB) has launched the updated "Information Literacy for Hong Kong Students" Learning Framework (Draft) in 2022 for schools to implement on a trial basis while continuously collecting feedback and suggestions from stakeholders. We have now further refined the draft in light of the views collected and will officially launch the "Information Literacy for Hong Kong Students" Learning Framework (2024).

### **Details**

3. The updated "Information Literacy for Hong Kong Students" Learning Framework (2024) has strengthened the contents including Information Evaluation, Cyberbullying Prevention, Personal Data Privacy Protection and Internet Addiction Prevention. Additionally, in view of the growing popularity of emerging and advanced information technology (IT) applications, a new literacy area titled "Recognise the ethical issues arising from the application of emerging and advanced information technologies" is added, which encompasses concerns related to artificial intelligence technology, including issues of laws and regulations, academic integrity, and excessive dependence on technology, aiming to nurture students as ethical IT users and prepare them to tackle

the challenges posed by innovative technologies. Schools can download the relevant learning framework from the EDB website (<a href="https://www.edb.gov.hk/en/ite/IL-learningframework">https://www.edb.gov.hk/en/ite/IL-learningframework</a>). We recommend schools promptly implement the Learning Framework (2024) and adopt a whole-school approach to actively promote information literacy education.



4. To support schools in the effective planning and implementation of information literacy education, the EDB will continue to provide schools and teachers with professional development programmes, on-site support, learning and teaching resources, etc. Relevant information and resources have been uploaded to the Information Literacy Education Support website (<a href="https://www.edb.gov.hk/il/eng">https://www.edb.gov.hk/il/eng</a>).
