Release of Results of Central Allocation

Frequently Asked Questions

Question (1) When will the results of Central Allocation be released?

Answer (1) The results of Central Allocation will be released on 3 June (Saturday).

Question (2) How should parents collect the 'Primary One Registration Form'?

Answer (2) Parents have to return to the Central Allocation Centre of their home school net on **3 June (Saturday)** or **4 June (Sunday)** to collect the 'Primary One Registration Form'. The operating hours are as follows:

9:30 am – 12:30 pm

1:30 pm – 4:30 pm

Question (3) Do parents need to bring along their child to collect the 'Primary One Registration Form' and what documents should parents bring with them?

Answer (3) Parents **need not** bring along their child to the Central Allocation Centre to collect the Form. However, they should bring along the parent's copy of either the 'Application Form for Admission to Primary One' or the 'Choice of Schools Form' for identification purposes.

Question (4) When should parents register their child with the school allocated?

Answer (4) Parents should register their child with the school allocated on **6 June (Tuesday)** or **7 June (Wednesday)**. The registration hours are as follows:

AM School: 9:00 am – 12:00 noon

PM School: 2:00 pm – 5:00 pm

Whole Day School: 9:00 am – 12:00 noon

2:00 pm – 4:00 pm

Question (5) Do parents need to bring their child along to the allocated school for the registration formalities?

Answer (5) Parents **need not** bring along their child to the allocated school for the registration formalities.

Question (6) What should parents do if they are unable to complete the registration procedure with the allocated school on the specified dates?

Answer (6) Parents can authorize in writing a representative to act on their behalf or notify the person in charge of registration of the school concerned to make alternative arrangements. Parents failing to register their child with the school on 6 June or 7 June without making prior arrangements will be deemed to have given up the school place allocated.

Question (7) For parents who have not applied for Central Allocation but wish their child to study in Primary One in September 2017, what should they do?

Answer (7) Parents should bring along the child's identity documents and proof of residential address to make application for arranging school places at the School Places Allocation Section of the Education Bureau on or before 31 August 2017. For details, they can contact the School Places Allocation Section at 2832 7700 or 2832 7740. For children arriving in Hong Kong after the commencement of the school term (i.e. on or after 1 September), parents should bring along their children and their children's identity documents, proof of attained academic qualifications and proof of residential address (both originals and photocopies) to register with the Regional Education Offices. Staff at the Regional Education Offices will assist them in obtaining a school place.
