	value. This talk aims to debunk various myths surrounding play and emphasize its crucial
	role in children's lives. During the talk, we will explore the unique aspects of free play,
	focusing on child initiative, involvement, and autonomy. Participants will gain a profound
	understanding of how free play nurtures children's growth across multiple dimensions.
	Moreover, we will explore practical strategies for incorporating play-based learning
	activities into the home environment to effectively foster children's development. Through
	demonstrations, participants will acquire valuable skills in fostering meaningful
	parent-child interactions and playtime at home. By the end of this talk, participants will be
	equipped with the knowledge to embrace play as a powerful tool for their children's
	holistic development.
