The STAR Platform launched two rounds of updates entitled <u>"STAR 2.0"</u> and <u>"STAR 2.1"</u> respectively in October 2020 and April 2021, among which include newly added and enhanced features to enable interested schools to use STAR as school-based formative and summative assessment tools. The newly added and enhanced features of "STAR 2.0" and "STAR 2.1" are as follows:
