The Overview of the Latest Development of STAR and WLTS¹

The STAR Platform launched two rounds of updates entitled “**STAR 2.0**” and “**STAR 2.1**” respectively in October 2020 and April 2021, among which include newly added and enhanced features to enable interested schools to use STAR as school-based formative and summative assessment tools. The newly added and enhanced features of “STAR 2.0” and “STAR 2.1” are as follows:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Providing split screen display for reading assessment tasks for language subjects • Open-ended questions added for language subjects • Teachers can enter / select comments for open-ended questions • Providing graphical presentation of performance reports 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Supporting listening assessments conducted through centralised / class-based broadcast • Supporting speaking assessments (including recording and file uploading / downloading) • Providing the overall correct response percentage of assessment items in a specific time period • Assessment items cover more question types and formats
