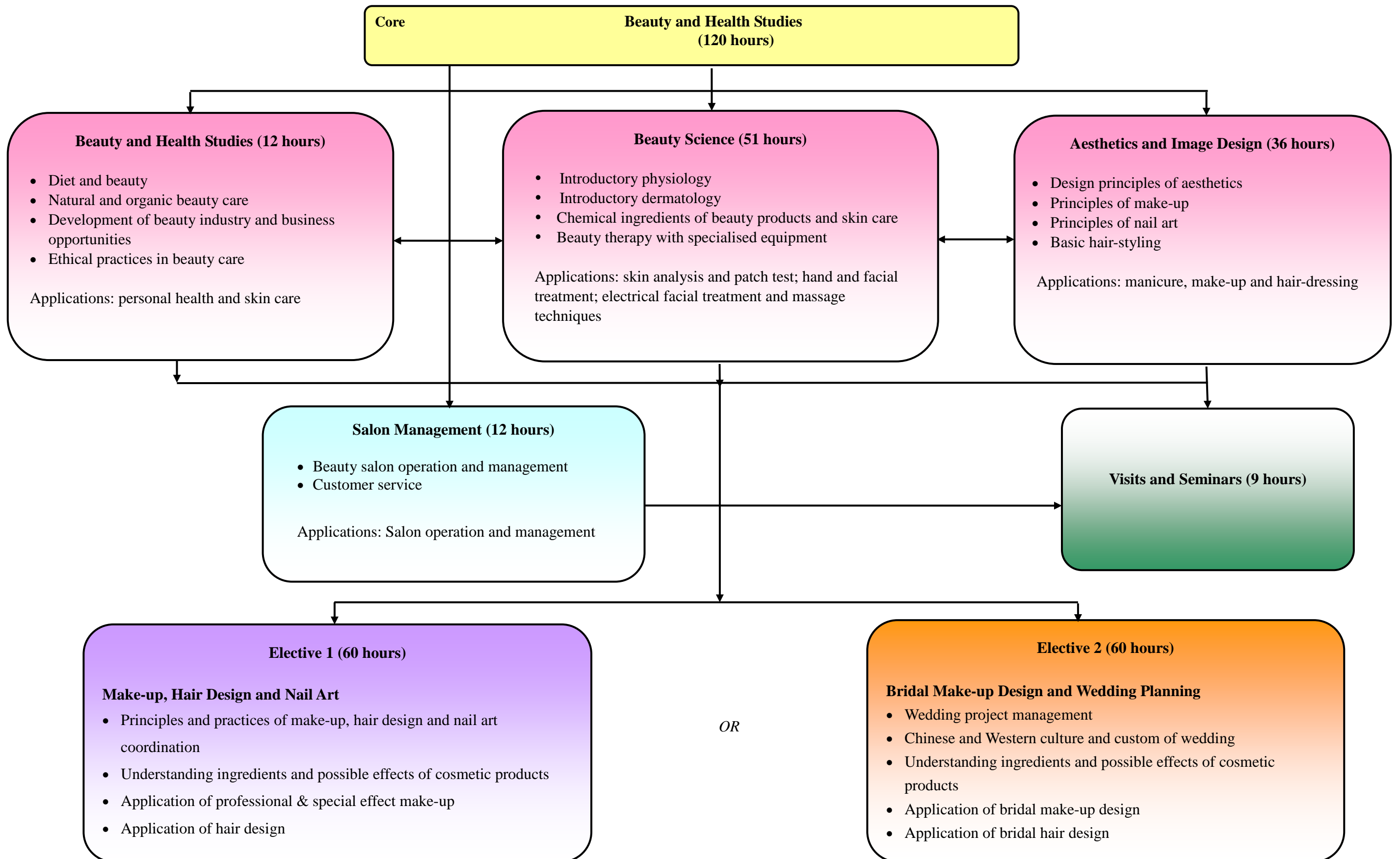

Learning Outcomes	<p>Upon completion of the subject, students should be able to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) understand and apply the beauty science knowledge of physiology, dermatology and aesthetics in the design of beauty treatment plans; (2) integrate and apply the knowledge of health and beauty care and the practice of hygienic and safety measures in beauty treatments and salon management; (3) learn and apply relevant knowledge and skills in aesthetics to a beauty plan for make-up, nail art and hair styling for image design; (4) appreciate and understand the principles of customer service as well as the business and ethics of the beauty industry; (5) plan and implement make-up, nail art and hair design through selection of appropriate cosmetics products and practices to bring customised and special effect for different occasions; and (6) develop self-understanding for further studies and career development in related fields.
