

## **Audiobooks on “Learning and Teaching Series on Geography of China” and Geography Online Game Platform for Understanding Our Motherland**

### **Purpose**

This is to inform heads of primary and secondary schools about the details of the captioned audiobooks and online game platform.

### **Details**

2. In response to The Chief Executive’s 2022 Policy Address to strengthen students’ sense of national identity and national pride, the Education Bureau (EDB) has produced three sets of audiobooks (comprise Chinese and English versions for upper primary and junior secondary school students) to enhance students’ understanding of the geography of our country. These three sets of audiobooks cover three different themes, namely (1) Population, (2) Natural Hazards and Mitigation Measures I: Typhoon, Flood and Drought, and (3) Natural Hazards and Mitigation Measures II: Sandstorm, Desertification and Earthquake. They are the second batch of the “Learning and Teaching Series on Geography of China”, which contains 11 sets of audiobooks in total.

3. The EDB has also developed another four games in the Geography Online Game Platform “Understanding Our Motherland”. The themes include (1) Agriculture, (2) Population, (3) Industry and Natural Resources, and (4) Natural Disasters. In addition to the four themes developed in the first phase, eight online games have been launched to allow students to learn the geography of our country in a relaxed and pleasant atmosphere, and to cultivate the attitude and ability of self-learning. The platform contains interactive games designed for upper primary and junior secondary students respectively. It also contains reference materials for students’ prior reading before playing the games.
