#### Rewinding the Exquisite

I have a very close bonding with my dogs – Momo and Coco. After experiencing Momo's death, I met Coco which resembles Momo in many ways, as if it were Momo's incarnation. I treasure my memories with Momo in its absence. Despite the photo records of Momo, there were still missing details no matter how hard I tried to recall. So, I created the series of work to reconstruct our memories.

Memento shows the three stages of me with Momo's presence – Momo protecting the infant me, watching the crying me on the other side and teenager me approaching Coco. The work was displayed in a tidy way to create a sense of ritual. My relationship and memories with my dogs are valuable that should be carefully preserved.

Traces shows the daily incidents by drawing objects of Coco and places we often go. I decided not to directly draw Coco and me, but present my idea in a more subtle and indirect approach to show the meaning and my feeling with representation of objects and simple descriptions. Specific memory would be unfolded when I see the related objects or go to specific places, therefore I placed the postcards like grids to represent the 30 memory boxes.

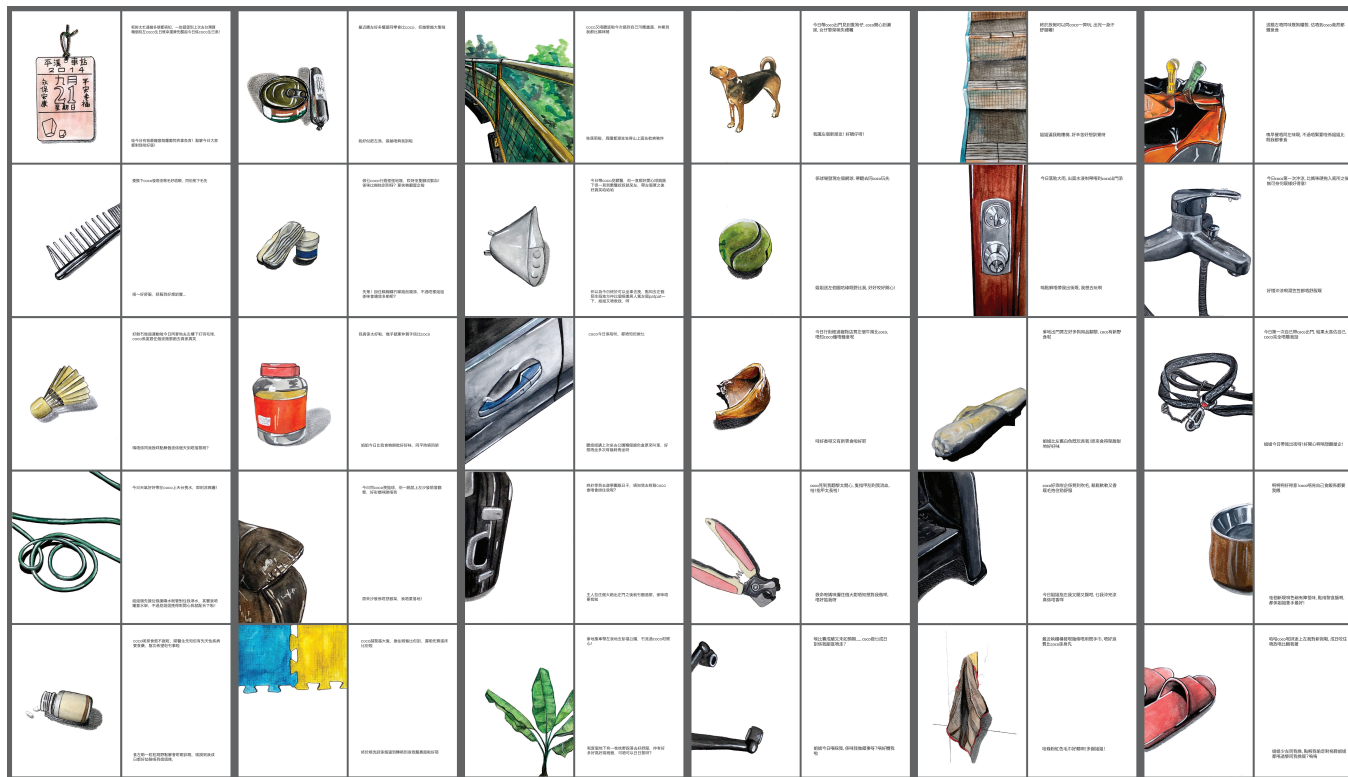

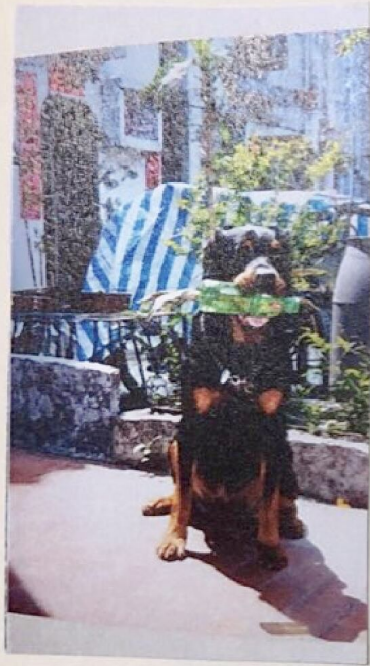

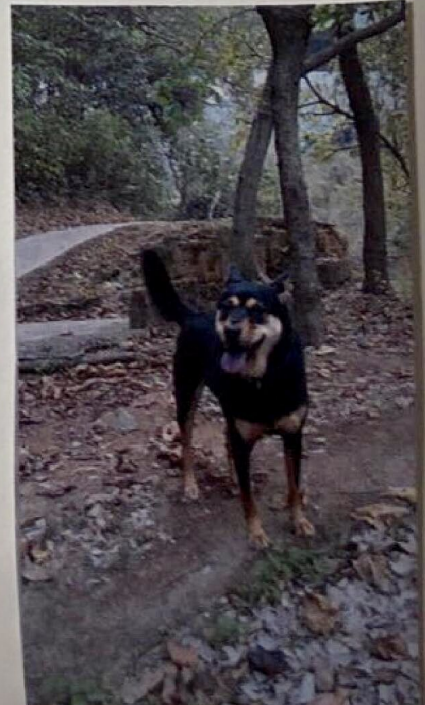
- after Momo's death, I had always been pleading my mother to get another dog

## Reflection

Chan Sin Hing draws in a dilapidated family ancestral house where she has two dogs. The dogs later became an integral part of the picture. Many times before sunset, she draws all kind of things on the canvas, accompanied by the sound of barking.

I like how Chan Sin Hing's drawings are in specific colour tone. The shadows, composition of drawing are very unique and eye-catching. When I was walking Coco, I always stood beside and quietly watch her sniffing around, sometimes standing and 'smile' at me.

I relate much in Chan Sin Hing's drawings if she draws the essence of dogs. I think her colour skills and composition inspires me to learn them.



## Reincarnation in dogs Judy Fridono

- Rina was her 13 year old golden / lab mix. She had laryngeal paralysis for about a year when her breathing became a crisis the Friday of Memorial day weekend in 2016. She was sedated and ended up in critical care with aspiration pneumonia
- After a couple days when Rina was gone, Judy had profound 'knowing' deep within her soul that Rina was coming back and they would reunite. She was never so certain about anything in her life
- Judy decided to adopt another puppy. Rina like essential oils and frankincense was her favourite. So she put some on her wrist and put it in front of each pup's nose as she picked them up. When she took the 7th puppy in her hands, the puppy was flailing her arms like someone who was really excited. At the same time, tears welled up in her eyes, and every cell in her body felt like it was vibrating with an incredibly powerful universal energy. It was like electricity was going through her body... goosebumps everywhere.

### Reflection

I felt very much related to Judy's story. Although our story were different, and I don't have much memories about Momo's death because I was too small, I did have the feeling that 'electricity was going through my body' when I first met Coco at the adoption centre in Sai Kung. There was an indescribable feeling that 'there she is' when I held Coco in my arms. I remembered that there were other puppies to choose, and my parents suggested other puppies but I insisted choosing Coco.

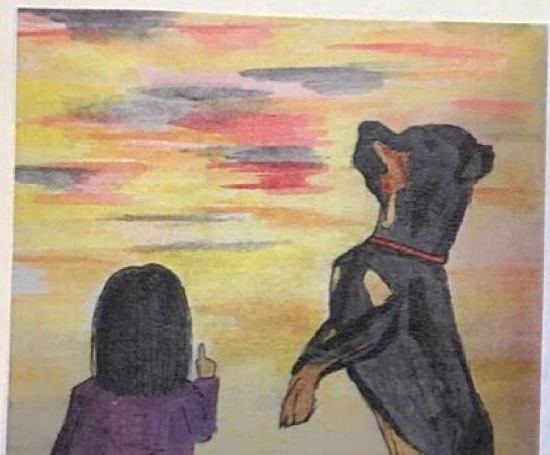

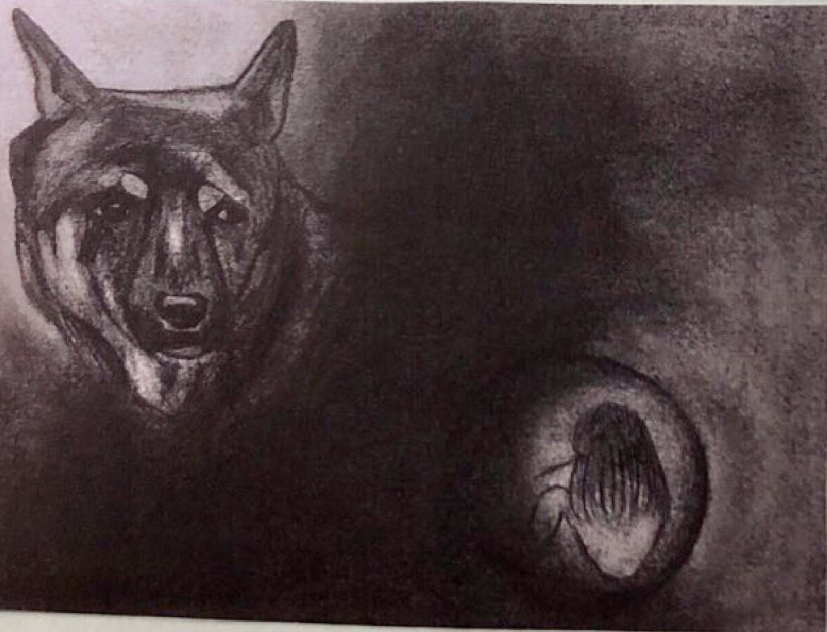

I wish to recreate scenes of 'baby' me with Momo and 'now' me with Coco, therefore I went digging through the old photos of myself. Sadly, I couldn't find many photos with Momo, but I've came up an idea of getting my sister to take some pictures with Coco. As my sister is two years old now, seeing her playing with Coco is like seeing another of version of myself.

\*(and my memories with Momo too)

I noticed that my pictures with Coco and my sister's pictures with Coco are almost mainly in a posture of hugging, relying and touching. As dogs can't communicate with us by talking, the connection and interaction between human and dogs rely on touching. Therefore, I decided to focus on the 'touching' parts in the photo to recreate the scenes.

- At first, I tried pencil to see what would it look like. However, I think that pencil creates a kind of blurry feel and the details are not sharp enough.

Then I tried painting acrylic on paper, which the details are much more clearer and the colours are vibrant and lively, not so dull like pencil.

I gathered a bunch of photos of Momo himself and photos of my sister and Coco. With the help of my phone, I cropped the photos and combine suitable photos of Momo into Coco.

## Artist

- Gideon Rubin, contemporary artist

- Works with themes such as childhood, family and memory
- Known for basing his pieces on anonymous photographs in vintage photo albums

→ his paintings borrow the figures, subjects and compositions from objects that have life and layers - things that tell a story, but altered in ways that have become characteristic of his style

## Reflection

I found out that Gideon Rubin's work is about the memory of something that is at the point of fading away. By blurring identifying details, erasing the facial features of human beings, I think he left a lot of imaginary spaces for us to complete these unexisting details.

When I was going through the photo album looking for suitable photos to use, I discovered that photos only can record a specific moment, some details of the memory were left forgotten which I can't clearly recall the complete memory but fragments.

Therefore, after seeing Gideon Rubin's work and knowing his idea, I decided to enlarge the photo and paint a cropped area of the photo. Without much background painted, I hope to let viewers picture the whole scene by themselves.

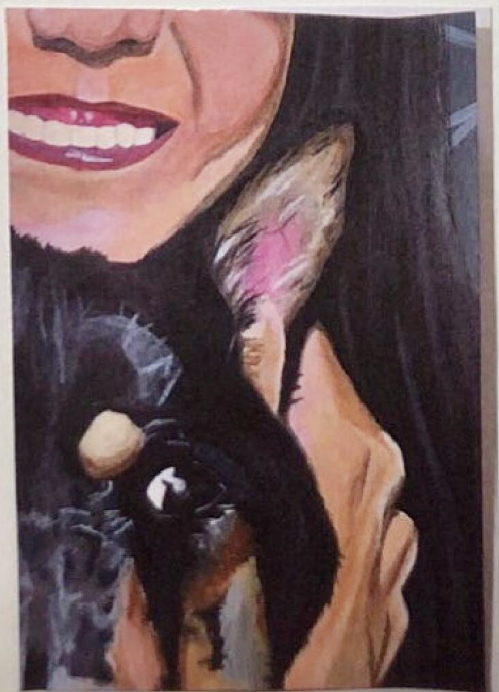
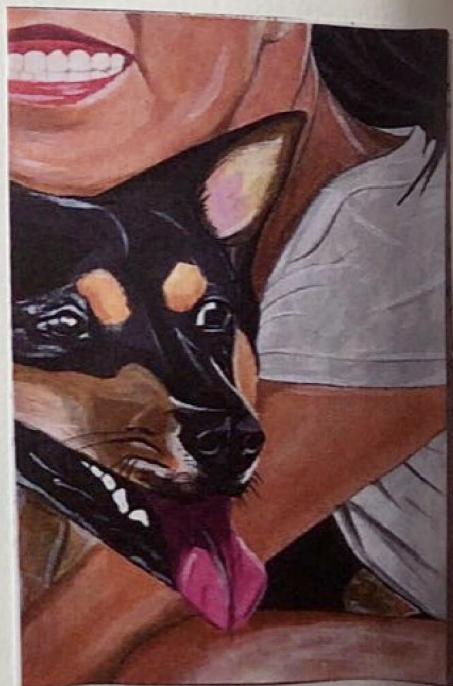

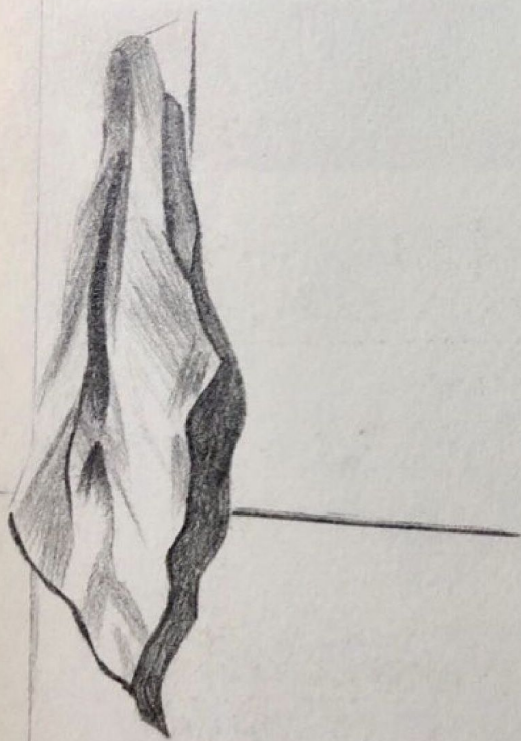

## Work 2

- I was inspired by actress 鄧九雲's work 《小姐狗與流氓貓》
- It is a pet graphic card book which lady dog - in the form of pet dog Cookie and Charlie, the range cat exchange letters. Through the first-person narration and observation of the two animals, the interesting dialogue between the animals show how dogs and cats are different in human life and at the same time the viewers can feel the love between animals and human
  - I love how the artist used exchanging letters as an idea. I always think about what would Coco tell me if she can talk, therefore I came up with an idea of putting myself in Coco's shoes to write series of sentences of what Coco is thinking in daily lives.

### 《小姐狗與流氓貓》

- take abandoned cats and dogs as subject, and share the life details from the time of adoption in an anthropomorphic way.
- Joanne Deng pays many attention to animal conservation, one reason is because her dog, the protagonist in the book *Cookie*, the dog was also adopted
- the book is all about little things in life, which reminds everyone to cherish and enjoy small fortunes and encourage adopting animals

### Reflection

Joanne Deng's work is my only inspiration for work 2. After finishing work 1, I have been thinking how to avoid directly drawing Coco to present my idea.

After reading 《小姐狗與流氓貓》, I was impressed by the simple drawings, they immediately reminded me of Coco's daily life in my house. Also, the cards are letters from dog to cat and from cat to dog. By interpreting thoughts of the cat and the dog makes the letters more interesting and fun to read.

Therefore, the idea of using postcards as work 2 popped up in my mind. I decided to write 30 incidents including both me and Coco's perspective. As for the drawings, I decided to extract specific element for example objects, sceneries etc to draw. As mentioned, I avoid drawing Coco and me in my drawings, I would like to leave space for readers to imagine the incident themselves.

《小姐狗與流氓貓》 uses lots of wordings to explain an incident, however I want to keep my wordings simple so that viewers don't have to waste a lot of time to understand the whole incident but have general understanding just by one or two sentences.
