

**Exhibition of Student Visual Arts Work 2022/23 -
Primary and Secondary Student Artworks
Notice to Participating Schools**



Objective

Exhibition of Student Visual Arts Work 2022/23 - Primary and Secondary Student Artworks (the Exhibition) is organised by the Arts Education (AE) Section of the Curriculum Development Institute (CDI), the Education Bureau. The Exhibition aims to display and acknowledge primary and secondary students' accomplishment in visual arts, and enable students and teachers to learn from each other.

1. Important Dates

2. Entry Requirements

- No specific theme is required for the Exhibition.
- Participants should be full-time students of primary and secondary schools in Hong Kong.
- Submitted entries must be the original works of the participants.
- Each entry should be submitted to the respective entry group according to **the level of study of making the artwork**.
- Participants may use any kind of visual arts forms and media, such as Chinese ink and brush, drawing, painting, printmaking, photography, sculpture, ceramics, video and mixed media, to express their emotions, ideas and daily life experiences.
- Number of entries to be submitted by each school:

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| Primary School | Each school may submit a maximum of 15 entries Lower Primary Group: Up to 7 entries Upper Primary Group: Up to 8 entries | Each Participant may submit a maximum of 2 entries |
| Secondary School | Each school may submit a maximum of 15 entries Junior Secondary Group: Up to 7 entries Senior Secondary Group: Up to 8 entries | |

- Size of each entry:

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| 2-Dimensional works/ Chinese painting and Calligraphy | Not exceeding 90cm x 120cm |
| Chinese painting and Calligraphy mounted as scroll | Not exceeding 60cm x 180cm |
| 3-Dimensional works | Not exceeding 100cm x 100cm x 120cm (H) |
| Outfits on dummies | Not exceeding 100cm x 100cm x 180cm (H) |
| Video clips | Not exceeding 5 minutes (MP4/MPEG format) |

- Entries with fragile, sharp, heavy materials, or not securely fixed parts will NOT be accepted.
- Entries should NOT be framed. Entries could only be mounted on cardboard if necessary.
- Entries which do not meet the aforesaid requirements will NOT be accepted.

3. Adjudication

- A judging panel comprising art professionals will select the artworks for display from all entries, and will select awarded artworks from the exhibits created by **INDIVIDUALS**. Group works are not eligible for any awards.
- The selection criteria include **creativity, aesthetics, manipulation of techniques and media, and communication**.
- The decision of the judging panel will be final.


4. Awards

The following awards will be presented to the Primary and Secondary Division respectively:

| Awards | Prizes |
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| Chinese Painting and Calligraphy Grand Prize (1 entry) | A book coupon at \$1,000 and a certificate |
| Media Art Grand Prize (1 entry) | A book coupon at \$1,000 and a certificate |
| Gold Prize (about 10 entries) | A book coupon at \$1,000 and a certificate |
| Silver Prize (about 10 entries) | A book coupon at \$500 and a certificate |
| Certificate of Merit (about 20 entries) | A certificate |
| Certificates of Appreciation | A certificate for the school teachers of the exhibited entries |

5. Submission of Entries

- All submitted entries will be handled with great care. However, the EDB, the curator or any related/affiliated organisations of the Exhibition will not compensate for any loss or damage of any entries arising from any causes.
