## 1. Important Dates

## 2. Participants and Awards

- Participants should be candidates of the 2022 Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) Examination in Visual Arts, and full-time students of secondary schools in Hong Kong in the 2021/22 school year.
- Each student whose portfolio is selected for exhibition will be awarded a book coupon at HK\$1,000 and a certificate.
- Respective school teachers of the selected portfolios (around 10) for display in the exhibition will be presented with Certificates of Appreciation.

## 3. Entry Requirements

- No specific theme is required for this exhibition.
- Submitted portfolios must be original works of the participants.
- Each school can submit a **maximum of THREE entries**. Each portfolio should include the research workbook and two pieces of artwork/ critical studies derived from the research workbook.

## 4. Intellectual Property Rights

All participants, their parents or guardians, as well as the schools should note and agree with the following:

- Participants need to ensure that the entries do not infringe any copyright and publication rights. Please visit the following website for details related to intellectual property: [www.ipd.gov.hk/eng/pub\\_press/publications/IP\\_e.pdf](http://www.ipd.gov.hk/eng/pub_press/publications/IP_e.pdf);
- Any entries that have infringed any intellectual property rights would NOT be accepted;
- The EDB takes no liability whatsoever for such infringement; and
- The EDB retains the right to edit, modify, publish and use all the entries in any forms for exhibition and education purposes, and has the final decision of the above actions.

## 5. Loss or Damage of Entries

All participating students, students' parents or guardians, as well as schools should note and agree with the following:


- All submitted entries will be handled with great care. However, the EDB, the curator or any related/affiliated organisations of the Exhibition will not compensate for any loss or damage of any entries arising from any causes.

## 6. Judging Criteria

- A judging panel comprising art professionals will select portfolios for display from all entries.
- In addition to the assessment criteria set for the School-based Assessment of HKDSE Examination in Visual Arts, uniqueness and progression shown among the two pieces of work are also considered.
- Results made by the judging panel will be final.

<b>Items to be Submitted</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) <u>Scanned file</u> of the duly signed and completed <u>Entry Submission Form</u> (Annex a);</li> <li>(ii) <u>Soft copy of the whole research workbook</u>;</li> <li>(iii) <u>Soft copy of the 2 pieces of original artwork/ critical studies</u>. The image(s) of each piece of artwork should be saved separately in JPEG format with resolution not less than 2000 x 3000 pixels; video clips should be saved in MP4 / MPEG format; and</li> <li>(iv) <u>Soft copy of the completed Information Sheet (Annex b)</u></li> </ul>
