The Exhibition aims to display and acknowledge primary and secondary students' accomplishment in visual arts, and enable students and teachers to learn from each other.

2. Entry Requirements

- No specific theme is required for the Exhibition.
- Participants should be full-time students of primary and secondary schools in Hong Kong.
- All entries must be the original works produced by the participants.
- Each entry should be submitted to the respective entry group according to the level of study of making the artwork.
- Participants may use any kind of visual arts forms and media, such as Chinese ink and brush, drawing, painting, printmaking, sculpture, ceramics, mixed media and digital media (including photography, video, animation, digital drawing, Virtual Reality, Augmented Reality, holographic art) to express their emotions, ideas and daily life experiences.
- Number of entries to be submitted by each school:

Size and specification of each entry:

2-Dimensional artwork/ Chinese painting and calligraphy	Not exceeding 90cm x 120cm	
Chinese painting and calligraphy mounted as scroll	Not exceeding 60cm x 180cm	
3-Dimensional works	Not exceeding 100cm x 100cm x 120cm (H)	
Outfits on dummies	Not exceeding 100cm x 100cm x 180cm (H)	
Time-based digital artwork (video, film, animation, holographic art, etc.)	 Duration not exceeding 5 minutes File size not exceeding 1 GB 	

- Entries with fragile, sharp, heavy materials, or not securely fixed parts will NOT be accepted.
- Entries should NOT be framed. Entries could only be mounted on cardboard if necessary.
- Entries which do not meet the aforesaid requirements will NOT be accepted.
- Device for display of holographic art, VR, etc. should be prepared by the participants.

3. Adjudication

- A judging panel comprising art professionals will select the artworks for display from all entries
- The selection criteria include creativity, aesthetics, manipulation of techniques and media, and communication.
- The decision of the judging panel will be final.

4. Awards

The following awards will be presented to the Primary and Secondary Division respectively:

Gold Prize (about 10 entries)	A book coupon at \$1,000 and a certificate

Certificate of Merit (about 20 entries)	A certificate	
Certificates of Appreciation	A certificate for the school teachers of the exhibited entries	

Remark: Except for time-based digital artwork, artworks created by group are **NOT eligible** for awards.

5. Submission of Entries

(a) Submitting entries for first round adjudication (soft copy only)

Remarks	 The image of each art piece should be saved separately in JPEG format wiresolution not less than 2000 x 3000 pixels, video clips should be saved in M / MPEG format with resolution not less than 720p; Late submission or entries with incomplete information will NOT be accepted 	

(b) Submitting the original artworks for final round adjudication

- Schools with selected entries in the first round adjudication for submitting the original artwork and the original copy of the "Declaration and Permission Slip" will be notified by fax in Mid April 2024.

6. Exhibition

- The Exhibition will be held from 6 to 15 June 2024 at the Exhibition Hall, 1/F, Low Block of the Hong Kong City Hall, 5 Edinburgh Place, Central, Hong Kong.

- Awarded artworks will be displayed on the "e-Gallery" of CDI and the AE KLA webpage.
