- All participants, including composers and performers, should be the students of the participating school.
- A subsidy of \$800 for the preparation cost will be given to each participating school team.

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#### **Submission of Creative Work**

- 1. Participating school teams are required to video-record the performances of their creative works according to the following requirements:
  - a) The recorded performance must be a complete performance;
  - b) The shooting angle must include all the performers and props (if any). The entire performance must be recorded with a static shot, and the video-recording equipment must not be moved during the video shooting;
  - c) The video-recording must be unedited and without any post production;
  - d) The video-recording must be in MP4 format with clear sound and vision; and
  - e) The video- recording must be submitted with the signed original copy of the Declaration and Consent Slip, the programme notes (about 150 to 200 words either in Chinese or English) and the music scores in PDF format.
- Schools must submit the video-recording of the performance, the signed original copy of the Declaration and Consent Slip, the programme notes and the music scores on or before 15 November 2023 (Wednesday) through one of the following methods:
  - a) Email to Curriculum Development Officer (Music)2 (<u>rebeccakylam@edb.gov.hk</u>) and Curriculum Development Officer (Music)3 (<u>chakyukyin@edb.gov.hk</u>); or
  - b) Upload to a Cloud Drive, such as Google Drive, and send the link to Curriculum Development Officer (Music)2 and Curriculum Development Officer (Music)3 by email; or
  - c) Store the video-recording of the performance, the programme notes and the music scores in a compact disk, and submit to the office of the Arts Education Section in person.

	2. The creative work should be performed by authentic musical instruments;

	4. The creative work should adopt different musical elements, such as			
	dynamics, rhythm, tempo, etc. with appropriate changes to express the ideas.			
	The melodic motive should be developmental, e.g. melodic phrases can be			
	connected to form a period; and			
	5. The creative work should have a complete and clear structure.			
Points to note	1. The creative work should be a music oriented work, with the support of using			
	multimedia and dance/ body movement. Participating school teams should			
	avoid focusing on storytelling, as well as using non-musical elements.			
	2. The ideas of the creative work should be expressed through music primarily.			
	It should not adopt words and lyrics, such as dialogue, speech, bailan and			
	singing, etc. in the performance.			
	3. To encourage the use of authentic musical instruments, participating school			
	teams should not use synthesizers and tablets to play virtual instruments			
	(except electronic pianos and digital pianos), and should not play pre-			
	recorded clips in the performance.
