3. Details

- Each school can send <u>one</u> school team to <u>participate in either Group 1 (Electronic Music and Authentic Musical Instruments)¹ or Group 2 (Authentic Musical Instruments)</u>. Each school can also send <u>not more than two school teams</u>, with <u>different students</u>, to participate in <u>Group 1 (Electronic Music and Authentic Musical Instruments)</u> and Group 2 (Authentic Musical Instruments) <u>respectively</u>. The entry of each team should be different.
- Each entry should comply with the requirements stated in <u>Annex 3</u>.
- All participants, including composers and performers, should be the students of the participating school.
- A subsidy of \$400 for the preparation cost will be given to each participating school team in the Final Selection round. An additional subsidy of \$400 will be given to each selected school team for the Final Performance.

Submission of Creative Work (Final Selection)

- Participating school teams are required to video-record the performances of their creative works according to the following requirements:
 - a) The recorded performance must be a complete performance;
 - b) The shooting angle must include all the performers and props (if any). The entire performance must be recorded with <u>a static shot</u>, and the video-recording equipment must not be moved during the video shooting;
 - c) The video-recording must be <u>unedited and without any post production;</u>
 - d) The video-recording must be in MP4 format with clear sound and vision; and
 - e) The video-recording must be submitted with (i) the signed original copy of the Declaration and Consent Slip, (ii) the programme notes in PDF format (about 150 to 200 words, either in Chinese or English), and (iii) the music score(s) and/ or tablet screen recording (if the music is a pre-recorded music).
- Schools must submit the video-recording of the performance, the signed original copy of the Declaration and Consent Slip, the programme notes and the music score(s) on or before 21 January 2026 (Wednesday) through <u>one of the following methods</u>:
 - a) Upload to a cloud drive, such as Microsoft OneDrive, and email the link to Curriculum Development Officer (Music)2 (rebeccakylam@edu.gov.hk); or

Name of the Creative Work and the Theme	Given by the participating school team

Entry Requirements	1. The creative work should be the original work created by students.
	2. The creative work should be performed by electronic music and authentic musical instruments. The work must follow the following requirements:
	 i) Each participating school team is only allowed to use the built-in instruments and features in a designated music application— GarageBand—for live performance and/ or playing pre-recorded music. <u>A maximum of 10 tablets</u> may be used for both live performance and playing pre-recorded music; and
	 ii) It is required to incorporate both the electronic music component and the authentic musical instruments playing in the performance, and/ or sounds created by different mediums.
	3. The creative work should adopt different music elements, such as dynamics, rhythm, tempo, etc. with appropriate changes to express the ideas. The melodic motive should be developmental, e.g. melodic phrases can be connected to form a section; and
	4. The creative work should have a complete and clear structure. The electronic music and authentic musical instruments components should be smoothly and meaningfully integrated.
Points to note	1. The creative work should be a music-oriented work, with the support of using multimedia and dance/ body movement. Participating school teams should avoid focusing on storytelling, as well as using non-musical elements.
	2. The ideas of the creative work should be expressed through music primarily. It should not adopt words and lyrics, such as dialogue, speech, <i>bailan</i> and singing, etc. in the performance.
	3. The selected participating school teams <u>must bring their own tablets</u> for the Final Performance and may need to adjust the design and content of the electronic music part to accommodate the venue and equipment limitations.

Points to note	1. The creative work should be a music-oriented work, with the support of using multimedia and dance/ body movement. Participating school teams should avoid focusing on storytelling, as well as using non-musical elements.
	2. The ideas of the creative work should be expressed through music primarily. It should not adopt words and lyrics, such as dialogue, speech, <i>bailan</i> and singing, etc. in the performance.
	3. To encourage the use of authentic musical instruments, participating school teams should not use synthesizers and tablets to play virtual instruments (except electronic pianos and digital pianos), and should not play pre-recorded clips in the performance.
