1. Objective

"We Learn • We Draw" Ocean Park Drawing Competition (the Competition) is coorganised by the Arts Education (AE) Section, Curriculum Development Institute (CDI) of the Education Bureau (EDB) and Ocean Park Hong Kong (Ocean Park). It aims to develop primary students' aesthetics, observation, sketching ability and conservation awareness through drawing animals and plants in Ocean Park.

7. Registration

- (i) Interested schools should register by submitting the **School Application Form** (**Annex a**) online from 9:30 a.m. 9 January to 11:59 p.m. 13 January 2025.
- (ii) Owing to limited quota, application will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Schools will receive the application results by 17 January 2025.

8. Rules and Points to Note

- (i) Each school should send 10 students (including Lower Primary Group and Upper Primary Group) to participate in the Competition. On the day of the Competition, each school should appoint two members of school staff (one of them must be the teacher-in-charge) to accompany their students. All participating students and school staff will receive tickets to Ocean Park for the Competition.
- (ii) Participants should be full-time students of primary schools in Hong Kong.
- (iii) Participants must use the coloured drawing paper (approximately A3 size, which is about 29.7 cm × 42 cm) provided by the organiser. Participating students should bring their own drawing tools and materials, such as drawing boards, pencils, fine pens, colour markers, oil pastels, ball pens and portable stools.
- (iv) Each entry should be submitted on an individual basis. Each participant can submit only ONE entry.
- (v) Participating students are required to conduct the Competition in a designated area within the premises of Ocean Park. Details will be announced during the precompetition briefing.

9. Adjudication

- (i) A judging panel comprising representatives of the EDB and Ocean Park, and art professionals/practitioners will select the entries for the various awards.
- (ii) The selection criteria include appropriateness to the theme, aesthetics, manipulation of techniques and media, and communicate power.
- (iii) The decision of the judging panel will be final.

10. Awards
