The Competition is organised by the Arts Education (AE) Section of the Curriculum Development Institute, Education Bureau (EDB), in collaboration with Ocean Park Hong Kong (Ocean Park). It aims to encourage primary students to develop their aesthetics, observational skills, and sketching techniques by drawing the plants and animals in the Ocean Park, thereby enhancing their awareness of marine resource and terrestrial wildlife conservation and sustainable development.

## 6. Registration

- (i) Interested schools should register by submitting the School Application Form online (Annex a) and completing the online form **from 9:30 a.m., 27 October 2025 to 11:59 p.m., 31 October 2025**.
- (ii) Places are limited, and applications will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Schools will receive the application results on or before 14 November 2025.

## 7. Rules and Points to Note

- (i) Each school should send 10 students (including **Lower Primary students and Upper Primary students**) to participate in the Competition. On the day of the Competition, each school should assign two staff members (**one of them must be the teacher-in-charge**) to accompany the students. All participating students and staff members will be issued Ocean Park admission tickets for the Competition.
- (ii) Participants should be full-time students of primary schools in Hong Kong.
- (iii) Participants must use the drawing paper (approximately A3 size, i.e., about 29.7 cm × 42 cm) provided by the organiser. Participants should bring their own drawing tools and materials, such as drawing boards, oil pastels, and portable stools.
- (iv) Each participant can submit only ONE entry and must enter in his/her individual capacity.
- (v) Participants are required to conduct the Competition in a designated area within Ocean Park. Details will be announced during the pre-competition briefing.
- (vi) All entries will be handled by the EDB and Ocean Park, and will not be returned.

## 8. Adjudication

- (i) A judging panel comprising representatives of the EDB and Ocean Park, and art professionals will select the winners of various awards from the entries.
- (ii) Selection criteria include relevance to the theme, aesthetic expression, technical skills, and power of communication.
- (iii) The decision of the judging panel will be final.

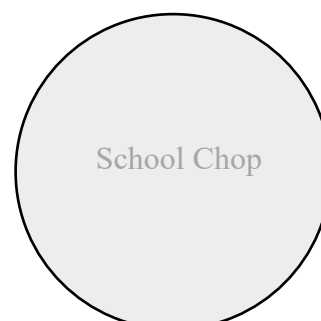
