## Campaign on "Promoting Positive Values and Attitudes through English Sayings of Wisdom 2025/26" – SOW Readathon 2025/26

### **Aims / Objectives**

Building on the successes of last year, the SOW Readathon is organised once again with an aim to further promote students' reading interests and habits as well as nurture a culture of reading at schools by engaging students in immersive school-based reading activities. The SOW Readathon this year centres around the overarching theme "SOW the Reading Seed – Discover as You Read" and the two sub-themes "Dream Big, Read Bigger" and "Wisdom Unites, Stories Connect". Schools are encouraged to provide students with holistic learning experiences through cross-curricular collaboration to enhance their literacy skills, broaden their imaginations, and cultivate a lifelong passion for reading.

#### **Details**

2. The SOW Readathon is open to **all primary and secondary schools** in Hong Kong and will be held within the period of **November 2025 – June 2026**. Schools are invited to register and recruit students as **SOW Reading Rangers**. Registered schools will organise an array of learning activities within and beyond the classroom, based on students' needs and interests, to promote reading, appreciation of SOW as well as proper values and attitudes, and actively engage students in performing their roles as SOW Reading Rangers. Interested schools should complete the Registration Form (<u>Appendix 2b</u>) in fillable PDF format and return it by email to <u>ele@edb.gov.hk</u> **by 6:00 p.m. on 31 October 2025 (Friday)**.

## **Support measures**

- 3. To support the organisation of the SOW Readathon at schools, registered schools will receive:
  - i) copies of the **SOW Reading Challenge Booklet** (Appendix 2c) that suggests a variety of challenges to support their organisation of student activities. The booklet contains a number of "Reading Challenges". These SOW and reading-related challenges vary in levels of difficulty and nature, such as reading to explore an invention, fantastic people of our country and the 17 Sustainable Development Goals. Participating students of registered schools, who are the SOW Reading Rangers, will be awarded a **certificate** issued by the EDB upon completion of **three or more** challenges with teachers' validation;
  - ii) copies of do-it-yourself (DIY) **SOW Corner Bookmarks** (<u>Appendix 2c</u>) templates for students to add spice to reading. The corner bookmarks are available in two designs, echoing the two sub-themes of the SOW Campaign 2025/26; and

- iii) SOW Reading Ranger Badges (Appendix 2c) for outstanding students as awards upon completion of the challenges. Schools can select outstanding SOW Reading Rangers to receive the SOW Reading Ranger Badge(s) based on their participation and performance in the activities.
- 4. The print version of the SOW Reading Challenge Booklet and the SOW Corner Bookmarks, as well as the SOW Reading Ranger Badges will be sent to registered schools in November 2025. The SOW Reading Challenge Booklet and the SOW Corner Bookmarks are also available in electronic version, which is accessible via the following webpage:

## **Sharing of Good Practices**

- 5. Upon completion of the SOW Readathon, registered schools are encouraged to submit a school-based record of their unique strategies and activities for fostering proper values and attitudes through organising reading and SOW-related activities in the school English Language curriculum with <u>Appendix 2d</u>. Schools demonstrating commendable performance will receive an award in recognition of their efforts and achievements.
- 6. Registered schools are also invited to nominate outstanding SOW Reading Rangers upon completion of the SOW Readathon. Shortlisted SOW Reading Rangers will be invited to engage in activities organised by the EDB to showcase their achievements and share what they have learnt and gained from the SOW Readathon.


## **Implementation**

#### Period

• Schools can freely choose the dates (any time between <u>November 2025 and June 2026</u>) and the number of days for conducting the reading activities.

#### Activities

- School-based Learning Activities
  - ➤ Schools can organise a variety of school-based activities for their students within and beyond the classroom, including classroom learning activities for appreciation of SOW through reading, Reading across the Curriculum (RaC) activities and interactive reading workshops in collaboration with other Key Learning Areas/the school library. Schools can also tap into various community resources (e.g. public libraries) and organise book fairs, reading clubs, and author visits to inspire students. Additionally, students are encouraged to participate in SOW-related competitions organised by the EDB to foster a dynamic reading culture.
  - ➤ Schools can refer to the resource materials (<u>Appendix 2c</u>) for organising the school-based activities, including the SOW Reading Challenge Booklets, SOW Corner Bookmarks and SOW Reading Ranger Badges, which will be provided for registered schools. Teachers are encouraged to make effective use of these resources to develop students' proper values and attitudes, nurture their interest in reading and create a positive reading atmosphere in school.
- SOW Reading Rangers Scheme
  - ➤ Schools recruit SOW Reading Rangers to promote a reading culture and encourage their peers to engage in reading through various initiatives and activities.
  - ➤ A **certificate** of recognition will be awarded to SOW Reading Rangers upon completion of **three or more** Reading Challenges in the SOW Readathon.
  - ➤ Schools can select outstanding SOW Reading Rangers to receive the SOW Reading Ranger Badge(s) based on their participation and performance in the activities.
  - ➤ Outstanding SOW Reading Rangers, nominated by schools and further shortlisted, will be invited to engage in activities organised by the EDB to showcase their achievements and share what they have learnt and gained from the SOW Readathon.



## School-based Record

 Schools are encouraged to submit a school-based record capturing highlights of the activities to showcase the effective strategies for promoting reading as well as proper values and attitudes in the school English Language curriculum. Good practices will be collected and disseminated on the SOW webpage and in EDB publications.




