SOW Aeroplane Chess Board Game and Activity Cards Set

•This set of board game includes a game board, an hourglass, a dice, 16 coloured plane pieces and a pack of 62 activity cards (i.e. 2 instruction cards, 40 action cards and 20 chance cards). It aims at encouraging students to reflect and share their thoughts and experiences related to positive values and attitudes centred around the themes "Cherishing Life", "Diligence", "Empathy" and "Respect for Diversity".



SOW Aeroplane Chess Board Game (2 to 4 players)

- Each player takes turns to throw the dice and moves one of his/her plane pieces according to the number rolled.
- If a player's plane piece lands on the "SOW logo" he/she draws an action card and reads aloud the instructions on the card. He/She then shares his/her thoughts/ experiences through oral or performative means. (Time allowed: 1 minute).
- If the player completes the action successfully, he/she can draw a chance card for bonus moves.
- The first player to get all four of their plane pieces to the centre of the board wins.
- Players can adapt the game by adding their own house rules.

Activity Cards – Action Cards

This set of action cards includes questions centred around the themes "Cherishing Life", "Diligence", "Empathy" and "Respect for Diversity". It can be used in connection with the SOW Aeroplane Chess Board Game or used alone to spark meaningful conversations in the English classroom to facilitate interactions among teachers and students.

• The player reads aloud the question/prompt on the keys corresponding to the icon and the colour of the SOW Speaking Cube rolled and reflects/shares his/her thoughts.

 The four SOW Speaking Cubes provide questions/prompts centred around the themes "Cherishing Life", "Diligence", "Empathy" and "Respect for Diversity".

• The cubes can be used as a learning tool for any speaking activities to engage students in doing self-reflection individually or to promote interactions in group activities.
