What is "Week of Positivity"?

What?

• A school-based cross-curricular English week in which schools organise their own activities that echo the overarching theme of "Leading a Positive Life" and the four sub-themes "Cherishing Life", "Diligence", "Empathy" and "Respect for Diversity" of the SOW Campaign 2022/23 to create a learning environment conducive to English learning and the promotion of values education



When?

- Any time between 6 February and 7 July 2023
- Flexible duration (number of days to be decided by schools)

Examples of Activities

7-Day Positivity Challenge:

- Organising a school-based Positivity Challenge to engage students in
 - > setting individual/class-based/school-based goals on leading a positive life and turning positive thoughts into action
 - > making plans to achieve the goals
 - > reflecting on the experience

School-based learning activities within and beyond the classroom:

Poster on 7-Day Positivity Challenge (Print version)

A collaborative visual display for teachers and students to set goals on leading a positive life



Poster x 1 (150 cm x 100 cm)

How to use the 7-Day Positivity Challenge poster?

- Set a time period to organise a school-based Positivity Challenge (individual/class-based/school-based challenge).
- Teach students the importance of goal setting and its relation to leading a positive life through learning activities.
- Invite students to set goals for the challenge.
- The daily challenge can be displayed on the poster in the following way:

Class-based/School-based Challenge

Display the poster in a visible area on the school campus.



Invite students to suggest different goals and finalise the list together.



Design paper cutouts for writing the goals on and affix them on the poster.

Individual Challenge

Print copies of the poster from the "Week of Positivity" web page.



Have students set personal goals and design paper cutouts.



Display students' posters on the class notice board.

A log book for student ambassadors to record the SOW activities they have helped organise/participated in

How to use the "SOW Ambassadors Passport"?

- 1) Recruit students to be SOW Ambassadors.
- 2) Instruct the SOW Ambassadors to record the SOW activities they have helped organise/participated in. (See pp.6-14 of Passport)
- 3) Guide the SOW Ambassadors to complete a self-reflection on the "Week of Positivity". (See pp.15-16 of Passport)
- 4) Verify the records in the SOW Ambassadors Passports upon completion of the "Week of Positivity". (See p.16 of Passport)
- 5) Submit the names of the SOW Ambassadors who have completed 10 or more SOW activities via Google Form (https://forms.gle/rggnu1F1KgFfVZgr8) on or before 28 July 2023 (Fri) for the issue of certificates.

 - A visual representation (e.g. a set of PPT slides, a photo collage, a short video clip, a newsletter, or any other forms) with simple descriptions (e.g. captions/titles/headings) of the school-based activities; and/or
 - A reflection on the "Week of Positivity" (e.g. written by the SOW Ambassadors) accompanied by photos
