Tips for AI Lessons

- Understand students' abilities and capabilities
- Keep the instructions short, precise and clear \bullet
- \bullet With groupwork, one device at one time
- Three seems to be the best number for groupwork
- Be adaptable, often things do not go our way







Integrating into English curriculum

Reading progress helps with <u>speaking and reading</u>. <u>Locating for specific information</u> after they have and while answering the comprehension questions. This also <u>frees up</u> <u>teachers' time</u> because the <u>students do the recording at home</u>. It also <u>helps to</u> <u>evaluate their own reading levels at home</u>.

ChatGPT can help students to <u>write better</u> after they have <u>done some research</u> and <u>received more reading input</u> from ChatGPT's responses. In order for to have <u>more</u> <u>accurate pictures</u>, they need to have a <u>wide range of vocabulary and adjectives</u>. In this process, they learn to <u>elaborate and to expand their sentences</u>. They also tend to be <u>highly motivated</u> when they are using ChatGPT as they can obtain <u>instant</u> <u>feedback</u> in the learning process.
