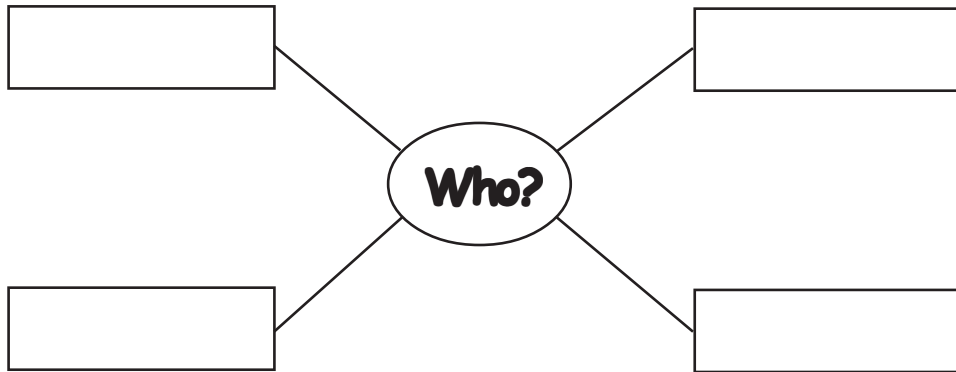
1. You are going to write part of a play. Before you write the play, read the story below.

The giant waited for Big Billy Goat Gruff to come onto his bridge. Big Billy Goat Gruff was big and very strong. When the giant tried to stop him, he charged at the giant and knocked him off the bridge.
