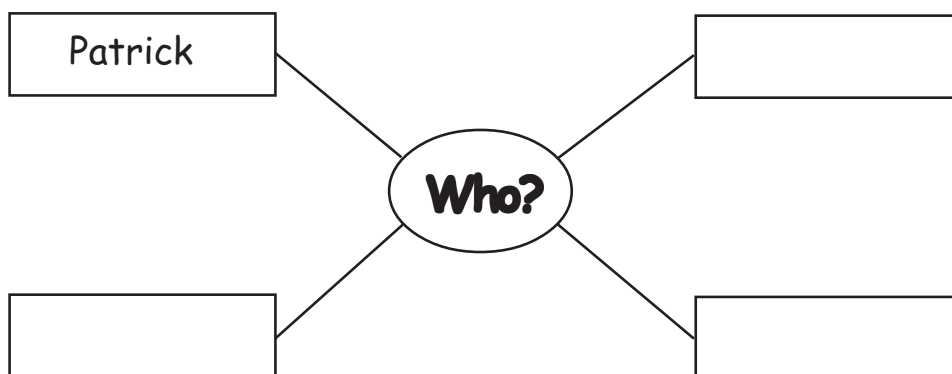
1. You are going to write part of a play. Before you write the play, read the story below.
