Characters:

Patrick - He is the eldest. He is clever and hardworking.

Patsy - She is the sister. She is kind and cheerful. She does not listen to her elder brother.

Peter - He is the youngest. He is lazy and stupid. He does not listen to his brother.

Big Bad Wolf - He is cunning and always hungry. His favourite food is pig!



Scene 1
(In a field at lunchtime)

Patrick: I can't cook as well as Mum. I really miss her cooking.

Patsy: Yeah, me too. It was always so delicious.

Peter: What's for dessert?

Patrick: That's all we have, Peter. I'm sorry.

(Patrick and Patsy start cleaning up. Peter starts to fall asleep.)

Patrick: Come on, Peter, we must find a place to build a house before the sun goes down.

Patsy: Yeah, let's go! I can't wait to live in my new house.
(Jumping up to her feet) Come on, Peter, get up.
(Helping her sleepy brother up)

Peter: OK, OK, I'm up. Do we have to walk again?

Patrick: Yes, unless you want to stay here and build your own house. I don't think it's a very good place.

Peter: I like it here. I can use the straw to build my house. It'll be very comfortable.

Patrick: You shouldn't be so lazy. Come with us. It's not safe here. Remember, Big Bad Wolf lives nearby.

Patsy: I agree with you, Patrick. I want to live in a house made of wood. We'll go to find another place to build our house. Goodbye, Peter.

Peter: Goodbye.

(Patrick and Patsy leave. Peter builds his house with straw. He is so tired that he goes to sleep.)



(At midnight there is a knock at his door. Peter is sleeping so well that he does not wake up. Big Bad Wolf knocks on the door again and again. Finally, Peter wakes up.)

Peter: *(Asking sleepily)* Who is it?

Big Bad Wolf: It's the Wolf. Let me in!

(Peter does not open the door.)

Big Bad Wolf: If you don't open the door, I'll huff and puff and blow your house in.

Peter: OK, OK, just a minute. I'm coming.

(Big Bad Wolf does not wait any longer. He huffs and puffs and blows the house in. Peter runs off in the dark, feeling frightened.)

Scene 2 (In the woods)

(Patrick and Patsy are walking in the woods. Peter is running quickly to find them.)

Peter: Hey! It's me. Big Bad Wolf blew down my house but luckily I got away in time!

Patsy: Oh, Peter! Are you alright? It's so good to see you.

Patrick: Yes, it's good to see you. Come on, let's go. We must be very careful now. We must build a very strong house.

Patsy: Look! There's a big pile of wood. We can build our house with it.

Patrick: Wood is stronger than straw but it's still not safe to live in. I don't think we should live in such a house.

Patsy: But Patrick, I want to live in a wooden house. OK, I will stay here and build my house.



Peter: I'll stay with you, Patsy. I'm very tired and I don't want to walk anymore today.

Patrick: OK, but I want to find another material to build my house. Please take care of yourselves. Goodbye.

Patsy & Peter: Goodbye.

(Patsy and Peter build the wooden house together. They are so tired that they go to sleep.)

(At midnight there is a knock at the door. Patsy wakes up to see who it is.)

Patsy: *(Asking kindly)* Who is it?

Big Bad Wolf: It's the Wolf. Let me in. I need help. I've badly hurt myself.

Patsy: No way! I won't listen to you. You tried to eat my younger brother. I won't help you!

(Big Bad Wolf wants to eat the little pigs. He huffs and puffs and blows the house in. Patsy and Peter run off in the dark, feeling frightened.)



Scene 3
(At the top of the hill)

(Patrick is building his brick house. Patsy and Peter are running quickly towards him.)

Patsy and Peter: *(Shouting)* Patrick! Patrick! Big Bad Wolf tried to get us but luckily we got away.

Patrick: It's good to see both of you. I think Big Bad Wolf is coming. We need to build a stronger house.

Patsy and Peter: We'll help you build the house. We don't want the wolf to eat us.

(Patrick, Patsy and Peter build the brick house together. They are so tired that they go to sleep.)

(At midnight there is a knock at the door. Patrick wakes up to see who it is.)

Patrick: *(Asking sleepily)* Who is it?

Big Bad Wolf: It's the Wolf. Let me in!

Patrick: No way! You tried to eat my younger brother and sister. I won't let you in!

(Patsy and Peter also wake up to see what is happening.)

Big Bad Wolf: Then I'll huff and puff and blow your house in.

(Big Bad Wolf huffs and puffs and blows but he cannot blow the house in.)

Patrick: Our house is very strong. You'll never eat us, Big Bad Wolf.

(Big Bad Wolf climbs to the top of the house and goes down the chimney.)



Big Bad Wolf: I'm going to eat you all!

(Patrick puts a pot of boiling water under the chimney. When Big Bad Wolf comes down the chimney, he lands in the boiling water.)

Big Bad Wolf: Help! Help!

Patrick: You're not big and bad anymore, Big Bad Wolf.

Patsy: How clever you are, Big Brother! You've saved our lives again. I'll always listen to you.

Peter: I'll always listen to you too.

Patrick: From now on, we'll live safely and happily together.

(The three little pigs hug together.)
