





'Mr. Holland from Mars'

-  Choose a pupil to be the conductor and the rest of the group arrange themselves in rows in front of her/him.
-  The conductor makes up goofy sounds (e.g. 'Whoop! Whoop! Whoop!') for the choir to make and designs a gesture to go along with each sound.
-  He/She can then lead the choir by doing the gestures only and the choir will make the sounds. He/She can raise his/her arms to signal how loud the choir should be (arms high=loud, arms low=soft). He/She should also come up with a clear signal for the choir to stop making noise, too (like drawing one finger across their throat to say 'cut').
-  Switch conductors and make up new sounds and gestures.
