## **LPF Writing Exemplar**

## A Visit to a Place

## **Task Description**

Students wrote a recount of their visit to a place at Easter. They gave a title for their writing, described the place they went to, the activities they participated in and their feelings.

## **Preparation**

Before the writing activity, students learnt the vocabulary about different activities in a module called 'Around Hong Kong'. To help students write the recount, the teacher brainstormed ideas with them in the shared writing process. More vocabulary related to activities were introduced. Students wrote the draft and they further improved on their work with the help of checklists and feedback from the teacher during the stages of process writing.
