Match the landmarks to the descriptions.

The Sphinx, The Eiffel Tower, The Leaning Tower of Pisa, Big Ben

1. This landmark was built for the Universal Exhibition in 1889 and weighs 10,100 tonnes. = *The Eiffel Tower*
2. This mythical creature has a human head, the body of a lion and the wings of a bird. = *The Sphinx*
3. This is actually the name of the bell inside the tower. = *Big Ben*
4. To get to the top of this tower you have to climb 294 steps on one side and 296 on the other. = *The Leaning Tower of Pisa*
