

Olympic Games Paris 2024



EMBLEM DESIGN

- The first time in history the same emblem has been used for both the Olympic Games and the Paralympic Games
- The design combines three separate symbols – the gold medal, the flame and Marianne, the personification of the French Republic.



- The year 2024 will mark the third time that Paris has hosted the Olympic Games. The first was in 1900 and the last was almost a century ago in 1924,
- In 2024, Paris will become just the second city to host the Olympic Summer Games three times after London.



MEDALS

Each medal features 18g of original iron taken from the iconic Eiffel Tower.

TORCH

- Designed by French designer Mathieu Lehanneur,
- Inspired from 3 themes of Paris 2024: Equality, Water and Peacefulness.

Height: 70cm



Weight: 1.5kg

Equality

- the same number of male and female athletes,
- perfectly symmetrical design,

Water

- the stage for the Opening Ceremony, the natural venue for Olympic and Paralympic events,
- the wave, three-dimensional and vibration effects on the torch,

Peacefulness

- flame symbolises the ideal of the Olympic truce,
- curves and rounded lines reflecting the desire for peace.

MASCOT 'PHRYGES'



- The Olympic Phryge and Paralympic Phryge mascots are based on Phrygian caps, a type of hat that has become an enduring symbol of freedom throughout French history.
- both Phryges are on a mission to start a revolution in sport, showing the world that sport can change everything and that it deserves a prominent place in society.
