



# Olympic Games Paris 2024




- The year 2024 will mark the third time that Paris has hosted the Olympic Games. The first was in 1900 and the last was almost a century ago in 1924,
- In 2024, Paris will become just the second city to host the Olympic Summer Games three times after London.

# EMBLEM DESIGN

- The first time in history the same emblem has been used for both the Olympic Games and the Paralympic Games
- The design combines three separate symbols
- the gold medal, the flame and Marianne, the personification of the French Republic.

## TORCH

- · Designed by French designer Mathieu Lehanneur,
- Inspired from 3 themes of Paris 2024: Equality, Water and Peacefulness.

#### Height: 70cm



Weight: 1.5kg

#### Equality

- the same number of male and female athletes,
- perfectly symmetrical design,

#### Mator

- the stage for the Opening Ceremony, the natural venue for Olympic and Paralympic events,
- the wave, three-dimensional and vibration effects on the torch.

#### **Peacefulness**

- flame symbolises the ideal of the Olympic truce,
- curves and rounded lines reflecting the desire for peace.



- The Olympic Phryge and Paralympic Phryge mascots are based on Phrygian caps, a type of hat that has become an enduring symbol of freedom throughout French history.
- both Phryges are on a mission to start a revolution in sport, showing the world that sport can change everything and that it deserves a prominent place in society.
