2. **“School-based Education Programme”**: Organised by the Hong Kong Fire Services Department (FSD) and supported by the Education Bureau, the Programme aims to educate students on how to extinguish a fire and evacuate in case of fire; apply cardiopulmonary resuscitation and automated external defibrillator for cardiac arrest patients; and apply the survival skills and response capability for self-help and helping others in the event of emergencies, terrorist attacks, etc. through a series of courses and activities.
