Details

- 2. The National Games, held once every four years, is the nation's highest-level and the largest national multi-sport event with athletes from provinces, autonomous regions, municipalities, special administrative regions etc. as participating units. It is organised by the General Administration of Sport of China. In 2025, the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) Government will co-host the 15th National Games (NG), the 12th National Games for Persons with Disabilities and the 9th National Special Olympic Games with Guangdong and Macao for the first time.
- 3. The 15th NG will be held from 9 to 21 November 2025. Eight competition events, including Basketball (Men U22), Cycling Track, Fencing, Golf, Handball (Men), Rugby Sevens, Triathlon, and Beach Volleyball; as well as one mass participation event, Bowling, will be staged in Hong Kong.
- 4. The One-year Countdown Event of the 15th NG (Hong Kong) will be held in the afternoon of 9 November 2024 (Saturday) (Ceremony Time: 4:00 p.m.; Carnival Time: 2:30 5:30 p.m.) at Central and Western District Promenade (Central Section, near Tamar Park). The event will include a countdown ceremony, thematic exhibitions and a carnival full of virtual reality (VR) games and sports demonstrations which are themed around the competition events held in Hong Kong. All activities are free of charge for public participation. Prior registration is not required. For details, please refer to Appendix 14a.
