

# FUTSAL







### **Knowledge 1 - Ball**

 Size 4 futsal.ball which is less bouncy (Commonly known as "low-bounce

futsal ball")



# **Knowledge 2 - Goal**

A goal is scored when the whole of the ball passes over the goal line, between the goalposts and under the crossbar



# **Knowledge 3 - Player**

 Maximum of five players, one of whom must be the aoalkeeper

 A maximum of nine substitutes



#### **Goal Clearance**

• The ball passes over the goal line (baseline) having last touched a player of the attacking team, and a goal is not scored

• Throw out by goalkeeper of the defending team within the penalty area



### **Corner Kick**

The ball passes over the goal line having last touched a player of the defending team, and a goal is not scored

kick-off starts both periods of a

match, both periods of extra

time, or restarts play after a

goal has been scored



# Knowledge 4 - Result

 The team scoring the greater number of goals during a match is the winner





## **Knowledge 5 - General**

 The ball must be put into play within 4 seconds after referee's signal



\*A player in an offside position (any part of the head, body or feet is nearer to the opponents' goal line than both the ball and the second-last opponent) at the moment the ball is played or touched by a team-mate is only penalised on becoming involved in active play



**Substitution Zone** 

- direct free kick is awarded if a player commits offences against an opponent in a careless of reckless manner or
- rewarding a direct free kick count as UU & accumulated fouls

## A kick-in is awarded to the opponents of the player who last touched the ball when the whole of the ball passes over the

touchline on the floor or in the air

## **Penalty Kick** A penalty kick is awarded if a
