Personal, Social and Humanities Education Key Learning Area: Optimisation Recommendations of Ethics and Religious Studies (Secondary 4-6) School Questionnaire Survey

Purpose

The purpose of this questionnaire is to collect schools' views on the optimisation recommendations of the Ethics and Religious Studies (Secondary 4-6) (ERS) curriculum. Schools offering this elective subject in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination (DSE) are invited to fill in the questionnaire.

Background

ERS is a senior secondary DSE elective subject of the Personal, Social, and Humanities Education Key Learning Area. The learning contents of ERS include normative ethics, applied ethics, religious traditions and religious experiences.

In response to the recommendations of the Task Force on Review of School Curriculum, the Curriculum Development Council — Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority Committee on Ethics and Religious Studies (referred to as the Committee hereafter) agreed that there is a need to create space to promote the whole person development of students and to revise the curriculum for more focused learning content in response to social development. After in-depth discussions, the Committee put forward the recommendations on optimisation, including reducing the contents related to the historical development of religions in their respective religious traditions and their respective social backgrounds, focusing on some of the contents for enhancing learning effectiveness, as well as updating the contents to keep abreast of the times.

The above recommendations on optimisation have been received and endorsed by the Curriculum Development Council.
