

## Analytical Chemistry Challenge for Secondary Students (2025/26)

### Aim / Objective

This is to invite secondary schools to participate in the captioned event.

### Details

2. The Analytical Chemistry Challenge for Secondary Students (2025/26) (hereafter, the Competition) is jointly organised by the Science Education Section, Education Bureau (EDB) and the Department of Chemistry, Hong Kong Baptist University (HKBU). The Competition aims to provide senior secondary students with an opportunity to apply their chemical knowledge and skills through hands-on experiments, cultivate their spirit of scientific inquiry, and foster their appreciation for the applications of analytical chemistry and their interest in chemistry.

2. The Competition will be conducted in two phases. Phase 1 consists of preliminary heat held internally at the participating schools, after which the best-performing team from each school will be eligible for a shortlisting assessment held at HKBU. The top 15 teams from this assessment will advance to Phase 2, an inter-school competition to be conducted at the laboratory in HKBU. 4. The target participants of the Competition are Secondary 4 to Secondary 6 students studying Chemistry. Interested schools should complete the application form at **Appendix 9a** and return it to Science Education Section, EDB by email ([cpsc@edb.gov.hk](mailto:cpsc@edb.gov.hk)) on or before **3 February 2026 (Tuesday)**.

5. The organisers will conduct an online briefing session on 9 January 2026 (Friday) to provide schools with more details about the Competition. All secondary school Chemistry panel heads and teachers are welcome to attend. Teachers can register via the EDB Training Calendar System (Course ID: ITED20250252).
