#### **Junior Secondary Business Case Competition**

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this circular memorandum is to inform secondary schools (including special schools) about the details of the "Junior Secondary Business Case Competition" organised by the Education Bureau (EDB), in association with Centre for Entrepreneurship and Centre for Family Business of the Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK), as well as the Hong Kong Association for Business Education (HKABE). Schools are encouraged to actively participate in the competition.

#### **Background**

- 2. The world in the 21st century is moving in waves of changing demands and uncertainties. Globalisation, technological advancement and the digital revolution, in particular, have drastically transformed the economic landscape. As economic growth is increasingly driven by the ability to create and innovate, fostering an entrepreneurial spirit across our society becomes more important in enhancing our global competitiveness.
- 3. To help our students navigate their ways through these changes, understand how rapid technological changes affect the business environment and develop their entrepreneurial spirit, Technology Education Section of the EDB, in association with Centre for Entrepreneurship and Centre for Family Business of the CUHK, as well as the HKABE, jointly launch the "Junior Secondary Business Case Competition" in the 2025/26 school year. Participating in the competition can help students enrich their fundamental business knowledge and skills acquired in the school curriculum, enhance their positive values and attitudes, as well as inspire students to explore different aspects of business in preparation for life, for learning and for employment.

#### **Details of the Junior Secondary Business Case Competition**

#### Aim:

- 4. The "Junior Secondary Business Case Competition" aims to enhance students' understanding in Hong Kong business environment, develop innovative ideas for the business, and apply business knowledge learnt in the school curriculum in real business world.
