

## Health Management and Social Care Expo 2024

### Outstanding Student Award

#### 1. Aim

- To showcase students' reflective thinking in designing and conducting field learning

#### 2. Target applicants

- Students can participate **individually** or **in teams** and only one entry in each category.
- Each school can nominate **at most three teams (1-4 students each) of S4 – S6** students to participate.

#### 3. Content

- Themes – **My Field Learning in Health Management and Social Care**
- Categories:
  - A. **Outstanding Field Learning Design:** acknowledging students their in-depth understanding on the HMSC knowledge and concepts as well as the innovative thinking during the process in designing the field learning.
  - B. **Outstanding Field Learning Reflection:** acknowledging students who show outstanding reflective abilities and critical thinking in the application of knowledge and the practical experiences in field learning.
- Schools should complete the nomination form and return it with student's work on or before **1 March 2024 (Friday)**.
- Each nominated student / team should submit a design / reflection in not more than 1 000 words (either in Chinese or English). Late submission or the content after the 1000<sup>th</sup> word will **NOT** be read.
- The shortlisted students / teams will be invited to give a 5-minute presentation to the Judging Panel about the design / reflection **on 1 June 2024 (Saturday)**, followed by a brief discussion on the reflection with the judges.
- **Gold, silver** and **bronze** awards will be given to the students / teams with outstanding performance.

#### 4. Rules of The Award

- The work must be original and should not be published or entered any competition before.
- Participants need to guarantee that the submitted work does not involve plagiarism or infringe any copyright.
- The Award results are determined by Independent Judging Panel. Participants shall not object to the results and awards determined.
- All entries submitted will not be returned.

## 5. Awards

Each category includes:

- Gold Award
- Silver Award
- Bronze Award

*The winners may be invited to experience and participate in health and social care work in authentic workplace settings.*

## 6. Judging Panel

- Representatives from the related disciplines in universities and experienced professionals of the related sectors.

## 7. Judging Criteria

### (A) Outstanding Field Learning Design:

● Effectively identify and define problems	20
● Demonstrate the ability to apply related theories, concepts, ideas and terminology in the design	20
● Generate unique and creative design concepts and solutions	20
● Estimate the effectiveness and limitations of solutions with the use of data and information	15
● Feasible design that can be easily translated into practical applications	15
● Organizes and communicates design concepts and solutions in a logical and structured manner	10

### (B) Outstanding Field Learning Reflection:

Criteria	%
● Clearly present the reflection that matches with the authentic learning experience	20
● Demonstrate the ability to apply related theories, concepts, ideas and terminology	20
● Support views with appropriate data collected from a range of sources	20
● Explore and/or examine own beliefs, assumptions, values and feelings on the experience	15
● Suggest sound and feasible proposals for improvement	15
● Presentation skills such as presentation of data and suggestions	10
