

Competition on Innovative Solutions for Promoting Health and Social Care

Aims / Objectives

The Competition on Innovative Solutions for Promoting Health and Social Care (Competition) is organised by the Technology Education Section, Education Bureau. It aims to encourage Secondary 1-6 students to apply knowledge and skills in the Technology Education Key Learning Area such as the applications of information technology, product design and social innovation to propose creative and feasible solutions that promote health and social care.

Details

2. The competition will be held on **28 June 2025 (Saturday)** and a **workshop cum briefing session** will be held on **9 November 2024 (Saturday)**.

2. Details as follows:

- **Theme: Innovative Solutions for Promoting Health and Social Care**
 - **Areas:** (A) Mental Health; (B) Healthy Lifestyles; (C) Supporting Carers; (D) Environmental Health
- Each secondary school can nominate at most two teams of students to participate (1-4 students for each team)
- **Category** - outcomes of learning activities or students' winning projects including prototypes, computer 3D models, webpage, mobile apps, services, activities and proposals
- **Judges and Selection Criteria**
 - Representatives from the professional bodies and universities
 - Service users
 - Representatives from the industries

Effectively identify and define problems	20
Generate unique and creative design concepts and solutions	30
Attractive presentation of the ideas / solutions	25
Feasible design that can be easily translated into practical applications	25

- The shortlisted teams will be invited to introduce their solutions to the visitors in the exhibition during 10:00am – 3:00pm on **28 June 2025 (Saturday)**. Gold, silver and bronze awards will be given to the teams with outstanding performance.
