“Preliminary Study of Artificial Intelligence” Strand (Pilot Version) of the Information and Innovation Technology Curriculum Framework for Primary Schools

Purpose

This circular memorandum aims to disseminate the “*Preliminary Study of Artificial Intelligence*” Strand (Pilot Version) of the Information and Innovation Technology Curriculum Framework for Primary Schools for schools’ reference, and to invite schools to nominate teachers to participate in related teacher training.

Background

2. The Education Bureau (EDB) released the *Blueprint for Digital Education Development in Primary and Secondary Schools* (the Blueprint) in mid-June 2026. The *AI Literacy Learning Framework for Primary and Secondary Schools* is a supplementary document to the Blueprint, outlining the learning objectives at each key stage in respect of both learning AI and applying AI. As mentioned in the Blueprint, the *Information and Innovation Technology (IIT) Curriculum Framework for Primary Schools* will be launched in the 2026/27 school year to strengthen the interface between primary and secondary Technology Education.

Details

3. The Ad Hoc Committee for the Review of Technology Education at the Primary Level was established under the Curriculum Development Council Committee on Technology Education (the Committee), which is tasked to review the current status of the implementation of Technology Education in primary schools and develop the above-mentioned Curriculum Framework. The Curriculum Framework consists of different strands, including “*Preliminary*

Study of Artificial Intelligence". To support primary schools in early planning and promotion of AI education and to implement the *AI Literacy Learning Framework for Primary and Secondary Schools*, the Committee recommends releasing the "*Preliminary Study of Artificial Intelligence*" Strand (Pilot Version) of the IIT Curriculum Framework for Primary Schools for schools' reference.

4. Schools are encouraged to plan ahead for school-based AI education and to conduct trial teaching in accordance with the "*Preliminary Study of Artificial Intelligence*" Strand (Pilot Version) of the IIT Curriculum Framework for Primary Schools.

5. The "*Preliminary Study of Artificial Intelligence*" Strand (Pilot Version) of the IIT Curriculum Framework for Primary Schools has been approved by the Committee and uploaded to the EDB's website.
