

With the optimising measures in place, the four SS core subjects should **take up no more than half of the total lesson time.**

Through reviewing and planning the whole-school curriculum, schools can plan the allocation of lesson time, provision of subject choices and arrangements for other learning experiences holistically to cater for students' different interests, abilities and aspirations.

Capitalising on the more diversified learning experiences within and beyond school hours, students can broaden their knowledge, develop multiple skills, and cultivate positive values and attitudes to achieve whole-person development.

How can students make the most of the released space?

① Study the Extended Part of Mathematics (MI / M2)

② Take an additional elective subject (including ApL and OL)

③ Engage in more in-depth study of subjects

④ Participate more actively in “Other Learning Experiences” as well as life-wide learning activities, and engage in other personal pursuits
