For details, please refer to the Education Bureau Circular No.5/2020.

Counting of School Days for Whole-day Schools in a School Year:

365 Days in a School Year — 91 Days of School Holidays — 2 Days of Additional Discretionary Holidays — 3 Days of Staff Development Days during which students do not need to attend school — 79 Days of Saturdays and Sundays not included in the school holiday list =190 Days
