Calculation of School Days for Whole-day Schools in a School Year:

365 Days in a School Year — 90 Days of School Holidays — 3 Days of Discretionary Holidays — 3 Days of Staff Development Days during which students do not need to attend school — 78 Days of Saturdays and Sundays not included in the school holidays =191 Days
