Solving Word Problems

Both writing narrative sentences at the beginning or at the end are two common ways to present the solutions of word problems, and it is acceptable to present the solutions in any ways as long as the presentation is clear and logical.

Example :




A box of eggs costs 15 dollars. Mother buys 3 boxes of eggs. How much should she pay?

	Narrative sentence at the beginning	Narrative sentence at the end
She should pay :		15×3
15×3 = 45 (dollars)	✓	= 45 (dollars) She should pay 45 dollars. ✓
43 (donars)		



Amy has 13 dollars. If mother gives her 8 dollars more, does she has enough money to buy two pieces of snack? Why?



Since 21 dollars is more than 18 dollars, Amy has enough money to buy two pieces of snack.
