(i)	<p>Portfolios: nominees should follow FTV's portfolio submission guidelines:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Applicants are required to submit their portfolios in a digital format and organize them in ONE e-folder before the interview. They must also authorize the interview panel to access them. An email regarding portfolio submission will be sent to those who are invited to the interview. 2. The portfolios should demonstrate candidates' creativity, storytelling techniques and ability of visual expression. 3. The mandatory portfolio must include the following items: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. ONE short film within 5 minutes or the best 5 minutes of your work. We prefer to watch an original continuous 5-minute excerpt from ONE project, instead of a 5-minute trailer of the project or showreel edited from different projects, unless you have strong reasons (e.g., you mainly work as a cameraman and want to show us different styles, or you would like to showcase your trailer editing skills). You should be the sole person in at least one of the following 6 key positions: Director, Scriptwriter, Cinematographer, Production Designer (or Art Director), Picture Editor, Sound Designer & Editor. b. ONE story written for a film within 300 words. If you have a screenplay, please summarize it in no more than 300 words. c. ONE film review or an academic essay within 300 words. If your original writing exceed 300 words, please summarize your points within the given word limit. d. FIVE of the best photos you've ever taken. 4. The optional portfolio could include works of various art forms as relevant to cinematic arts. 5. The time to assess a complete portfolio will not exceed 10 minutes. 	Mandatory
