Certification Course for Kindergarten Principals

- 1. The policy targets for professional upgrading of kindergarten principals and teachers as stipulated in the Education Bureau Circular No. 1/2007 on new Initiatives in Pre-primary Education require all new principals from the 2009/10 school year to have a degree in early childhood education, and one-year post-qualification experience. Furthermore, all new principals from the 2009/10 school year should also have completed the Certification Course for Kindergarten Principals before, or exceptionally within the first year of, their appointment.
- 2. Serving principals/teachers who had completed the Principal-ship Training Course for Kindergarten Principals and Child Care Centre Supervisors conducted by the University of Hong Kong (HKU) from the 2001/02 to 2002/03 school years and that by the Hong Kong Institute of Education (HKIEd) from the 2003/04 to 2005/06 school years are considered as having completed the Certification Course for Kindergarten Principals. It is hence recommended that they do not need to attend the Certification Course.
